



POLICY: TRUST LANDS POLICY

DATE APPROVED: December 13, 2008

Role of Committee

The Board of Trustees shall form a Trust Lands Committee, functioning as a subcommittee of the Board of Trustees, to carry out those activities and responsibilities directed by the Utah State Office of Education in accordance with relevant law and regulations, and will fulfill the following three purposes:

1. Meet to establish academic focus areas needing improvement, and determine and include measurable goals.
2. Determine how trust lands money will be spent to help improve in these areas.
3. Write and submit a plan (with input from the Board of Trustees) to the Utah State Office of Education to apply for these funds before the deadline.


Composition of Committee

The Trust Lands Committee shall be composed of the Principal, one teacher, and three parents of children enrolled in the school. Parents shall serve three-year terms, provided however that the first year, one parent will serve on the committee for that year only, one for the first two years, and one for the first three years. The Principal shall determine the length of the term for the teacher.

Election of Members

An election for Trust Lands Committee members will be conducted for the first year in November 2007, and will be held thereafter not later than Canyon Rim Academy's annual meeting. An election will not be necessary if, asking for parent volunteers in school newsletters, there are no more than three people who express interest in serving.
