

Student Disability Policy

Students With Special Needs

Students with Disabilities: In compliance with the section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act (504) and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), Canyon Rim Academy will provide reasonable accommodations to qualified individuals with disabilities. Students, parents, or employees needing accommodations should contact the school administrator.

Child Find/Identifying Students for Special Education: Any child, enrolled at CRA, who is suspected of having a disability, should be referred to the special education administrator or designee, who will initiate the process for determining eligibility for special education and related services. Referral may be made by any source including school staff, parents, and other individuals.

As part of the Child Find program, the school conducts a preliminary screening of new students who have not previously been identified as having a disability. All students in kindergarten are screened using a Pre-kindergarten Screening Assessment prior to the first day of school. The information from this screening will help teachers plan and implement appropriately targeted instruction.
